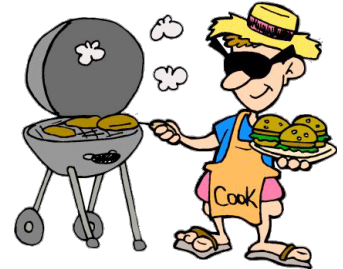


Past Events

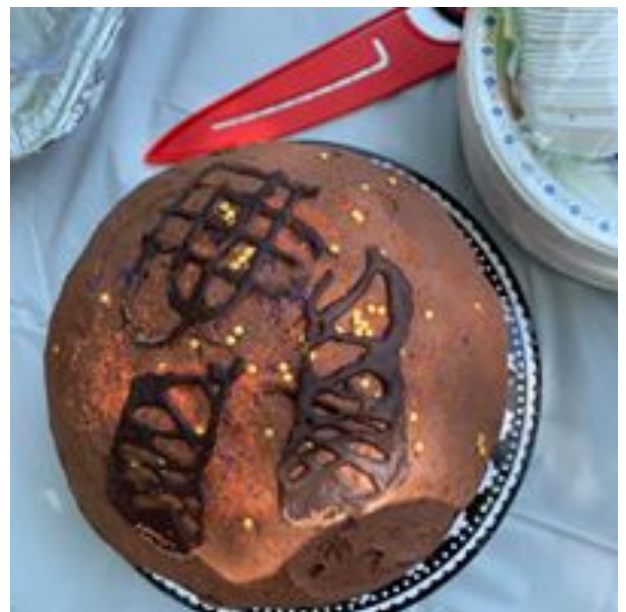

Blakey School of Irish Dance



The Blakey team had a special visitor to their classes on the June 1st weekend. Mackenzie Mahler from our sister school, Blakey O'Brien Calgary, came to visit. Mackenzie is the first Western Canadian female dancer to win the CLRG World Irish Dance Championships. Our dancers were thrilled to have such an accomplished dancer share her experiences with them and gained valuable knowledge from this world champion.

Our 2nd annual Blakey Regina Recital was held at Campbell Collegiate on June 1st and hosted by our parents group, the Regina Irish Dance Parents Association (RIDPA). The recital was a success again this year with all our dancers performing for family and friends. The Blakey Regina Spirit Awards were also handed out at the recital with Farah Miller receiving the Junior Spirit Award and Megan Beach receiving the Senior Spirit Award.

Even though there was no Irish Pavilion this year our dancers were guest performers at the Scottish Pavilion on Saturday June 1st at the International Trade Centre. This was also the 1st Blakey performance for 3 of our adult dancers and they were well received by the audience.

Our dancers traveled to the Calgary Western Canadian Open held at the Western Calgary Airport June 8 and 9. Our dancers received several medals and podium places with special note to the following: Alyssa Woolsey for placing 1st in her Preliminary on both days qualifying her to move into U11 Open Championships and Ayva Purdue for placing 1st in her U10 Novice/Prizewinner Treble Reel – halfway to Prelim.

The Blakey Regina group had the most dancers attending the 2019 North American Irish Dance Championships since Blakey Regina opened in 2013. This year was very special for these dancers as the North American National Championships was held on Canadian soil from July 1 – 5 in Vancouver, BC. The Regina dancers who attended were: Megan Beach, Aobha MacLoone, Sierra Davis-Fiacco, Rakya Subramanian & Alyssa Woolsey. Laura Schaan, who is originally from Regina, also attended. With most of our dancers being first or second time competitors, we did not see a recall for a third round from any of our Saskatchewan dancers, but our dancers danced well and made us proud.

Our dancers made their debut performance at the 44th Motif Multicultural Festival in Moose Jaw on July 13th. Even though it was a very hot day and a small number of dancers were able to attend (including 3 adult dancers) the performance went very well. We hope to attend again in the future!

The dancers will have several opportunities this summer to attend workshops throughout Western Canada to prepare for the first competition of the dance season, the River City Feis which will be held in Saskatoon on September 21 & 22. There will be a workshop this year in Regina from August 27 – 29. As well dancers will have the opportunity to attend workshops with our sister schools in Kelowna, Saskatoon and Calgary.

We would like to welcome Amy Hepting as our new resident instructor who will work alongside our TCRG Luanne Schlosser to coach classes this dance season. This year classes are being offered during the weekdays: Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays.

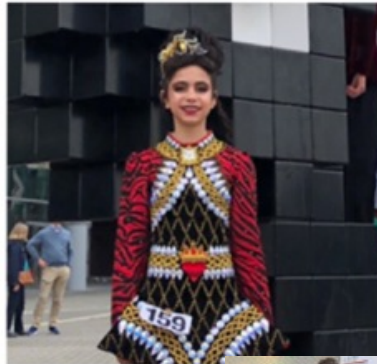
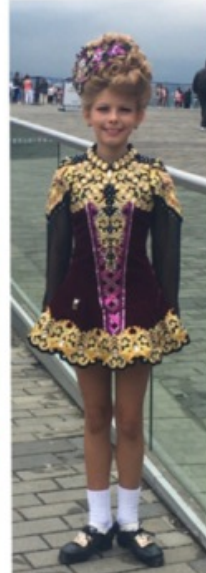
